Transportation: Charleston International Airport is located only 12 miles from downtown Charleston, approximately 17 minutes from Charleston Place, door to door. The majority of all flights traveling to and from Charleston are on Delta and USAir from their respective Atlanta and Charlotte hubs. Total, there are 22 flights a day from these 2 cities whose airports play host to countless flights world-wide.
